USE POLICY

The Village of Speculator assumes no responsibility or liability for inclement weather. Proof of certificate of insurance, with the Village of Speculator as additionally insured, must be provided by businesses and organizations using any Village facility.

Generally, alcohol is not permitted in any Village Park. Approval will only be considered for events that have a licensed purveyor. Purveyor must provide a certificate of insurance indemnifying the Village, proof of liquor license to service alcohol and a caterer’s permit as required by NYS Consolidated law—Alcohol Beverage Control, Article 7, §98² to the Village Board of Trustees at least two (2) weeks prior to the event to allow for Board evaluation. Failure to provide license and certificate of insurance when required will lead to denial of use.

The Village of Speculator reserves the right to revoke permission of use.

A refundable deposit in the amount of \$100 must be paid to the Village of Speculator by ALL renters and non-profit organizations within Speculator and Lake Pleasant. The deposit will be returned after confirmation of no damage to the facilities and all trash was removed by the renter.

There is a non-refundable fee in the amount of \$50 for Lake Pleasant residents and \$100 for all other non-residents. Non-residents are defined as persons not residing or owning property within the Village of Speculator or Town of Lake Pleasant. All tables/chairs/etc. must be removed within 24 hours of the use of the property.

Event afterhours/weekend garbage pick-up will be provided upon request for a fee of \$100.

All deposits and fees should be remitted to the Village of Speculator Clerk – Treasurer at the Village Hall within ten (10) days of the event. Checks can be made payable to the Village of Speculator.

AGREEMENT

I/we have read and agree to conform to the above rules and conditions for the use of the Village of Speculator facilities noted above and attached.

I/we agree to abide by all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances which pertain to the use of said property and agree to pay for any damage to same, as a result of use.

I/we further agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Village, its officials and employees, from and against any and all liability, loss, damages, claims, or actions (including costs and attorney fees) for bodily and/or property damage, to the extent permissible by law, arising out of or in connection with use of said property.

I/we further expressly certify that I/we will be responsible for any damage or loss sustained to the grounds, buildings or equipment occurring, or unusual clean-up required, as a result of my and/or my organization’s use of the facilities.

VILLAGE OF SPECULATOR PARKS & PLAYGROUNDS
YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING PARK RULES
PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING:

- ALCOHOL** Generally, alcohol is not permitted in any Village Park. Approval will only be granted for events that have a licensed purveyor who must provide a certificate of insurance indemnifying the Village, proof of liquor license to service alcohol and a caterer's permit as required in §98 of the NYS Consolidated Law - Alcoholic Beverage Control, Article 7, to the Village Board of Trustees at least two (2) weeks prior to the event.
- GLASS** No glass beverage containers allowed in Village Park.
- DOGS** Dogs must be leashed and under the control of its master at all times. Owners must clean up after their pet.
- BICYCLES** Bicycles must observe all vehicular codes. Riders are expected to be courteous and yield to pedestrian traffic. Helmets must be worn at all times by those requiring them. Bicycle riding is not allowed in the pavilion, basketball court or on the ballfield.
- CAMPING** No overnight camping is allowed except by Special permission of the Village Board of Trustees. Speculator parks are "day use" only.
- CAMP FIRES** No campfires allowed³.
- NOISE** No loud or unusual noises are allowed. All noise must comply with the Hamilton County Noise Law.
- VEGETATION** No taking, cutting or injury of any vegetation in the park is allowed.
- MOTORIZED VEHICLES** Motorized vehicles are prohibited from public property designated as walkways and any grass covered areas except designated parking area.
- WEAPONS, FIREARMS OR FIREWORKS** No person shall possess or discharge weapons, firearms, or fireworks in any Village Park.
- CLEAN UP** Upon completion of the event, the facilities must be left clean. Any additional cleaning performed by Village forces will be charged to the Permittee.
- PARK HOURS** The Village of Speculator Park is open from dawn to dusk. The Pavilion is used by special permission in excess of these stated hours. The Village Park areas are public spaces and therefore, the public has access to any part of the park during regular hours. Park areas cannot be reserved for the exclusive use of any one group and access to the area by the general public must remain available at all times. It is unlawful to obstruct the free travel of any vehicle or pedestrian over any of the walks or roads of any park property.
